Patients facing a life-limiting illness whose care needs exceed those that can reasonably be provided in the comfort and familiarity of home currently have no alternative other than going to a hospital or nursing home to die. To meet the needs of these patients and their loved ones Hospice of the Rapidan is planning to build a residential hospice house which will provide around-the-clock care designed specifically for hospice patients provided by our specially trained staff. The serene and "home-like" atmosphere will focus on the comfort.

There is currently no such facility anywhere in Fauquier, Culpeper, Madison, Orange or Rappahannock Counties. Through the extraordinary generosity of Robert and Betty Niles of Sumerduck we have recently received a donation of 14 acres in Fauquier County on which to build our hospice house.

During the coming year Hospice of the Rapidan will launch a capital campaign to fund the construction of
